

Please not that the last name is spelled Gieger, Geiger, Kegar and Gyger in records. It is pronounced like "Gigger." I have not changed spelling in documents.

Jesse Gieger was b 20 March 1793 and d 20 October 1871 in Covington Co., MS. He married Tabitha Martin in 1813. They had eight children. He was the son of Abraham Gieger.

Probate Record Book 5, Page 2, filed 15 July 1887(?):

Jesse Geiger Estate-died in 1871 leaving a small personal estate consisting of a few head of cattle, one wagon, and some property not exceeding \$200. Zachariah Geiger (signed Z. Geiger), petitioner (and son of Jesse Geiger) only one living convenient to property, except one other who petitioner considers wholly unfit to administrate.
