**Document Title: John Thomas Springer - Sally Glasscock Springer Bible,
Dated 1796 - 1898**

The Bible was in the possession of Mrs. C.A. (Springer Morris) Beebe in 1961 and transcribed by Berniece Miller Springer, wife of William Burton Springer, Jr., of Kansas City, great-grandson of John Thomas Springer. The transcription follows her handwritten summary and not a line-by-line transcription, including the way she organized the information. The location of the Bible is unknown in 2007.

The title page showed that the Bible was published by the American Bible Society in 1856, 30th edition.

"Presented by Rev. J.N.[W.] Springer to J.T. and S.A. Springer, September 26, 1857."

John T. and Sally (Glasscock) Springer family information:

John Thomas Springer was born March 20th 1829 and died April 29, 1867.

Sallie A. Glasscock was born April 22, 1828 at Cedar Grove, Richmond Co., Va., and died March 22, 1905. She died in West Fork, Ark. 76 years and 11 months on March 22, 1905.

They married Dec. 14, 1853, at her father's in Pettis Co., MO, by the Rev. J. H. Howe.

Marriages:

Aldea Amazon Glasscock was married to Mary Burgess Smith at the house of Doc^r John Y. Chinn, in the county Richmond in the State of Virginia by the Rev. Wm Forrester, a minister of the M.E. Church on the 10th day of October 1822.

Deaths

Mary Burgess Glasscock, wife of A.A. Glasscock, died in Pettis County, Mo. and was buried in the family grave year 12 of June 1861.

Aldea A. Glasscock died in Pettis County on the 19th day of Nov. 1877 and was buried by the side of his wife, Mary B. in the family grave yard.

Milton Syms Glasscock, Father of A.A. Glasscock, died at Indian Banks, March the 10th 1815 and was buried there, aged 49 years.

Ann Timson [Simpson] Glasscock, Mother of A.A. Glasscock, died in Pettis County, Missouri on the 18th day of April, 1850, and buried in the Family grave yard.

Births

Aldea Amazon Glasscock was born in Matthews County in the state of Virginia on the 3rd of November, 1796.

Mary Burgess Smith was born at Smithfield, Lancaster [Co.], Virginia on the 11th day of October 1806.

Sally Ann Glasscock was 3rd child of first 7 born in Virginia, the 7th, Louisa, being born the 5th October 1836. The 8th, Aldea Amazon Glasscock (Jr.) was born in Cooper Co. State of Mo. 6th day of Oct. 1838. The 9th, Margarite [Margaret] Timson was born in Pettis Co., Mo., 11th August 1840.

Five more children born in Pettis Co., MO, plus two stillborn (one stillborn, July 28, 1833, Aldea A. Glasscock, Jr., in Virginia)

Total - 14 living children, 3 stillbirths

Last, or 14th baby, Eli Everett Glasscock, born Dec. 17th 1847.
