Eugene Springer, b 1854 in Saline Co., Missouri, was the son of John Thomas Springer and Sally Ann Glasscock Springer and the grandson of The Rev. John N.W. Springer and Eliza Pilcher Springer. Eugene was a Methodist minister. He died in 1898, in Saline Co., Missouri, leaving his wife and young children. Hannah Margaret "Maggie" Springer (b 1861 IL) was the daughter of J Wilhelm "William Leaton (1828 GER - 1907 MO) and his wife, Lucinda Victoria Davis Leaton, b 1839.
