SPRINGER.—At his residence, in Pettis county, Mo., at 5 o'clock, on Monday morning, April 29th, 1867, of consumption, John T.

Springer aged 37 years.

He suffered much for many months before his death, but died in peace. He was a member of the M. E. Church, South, and is the last of twelve children. He desired very much to see his father (whom he supposed was yet living) before he died, and frequently wrote to him; the last time about three or four weeks before his death, when very weak. He wrote as long as he could and got his wife to finish the letter, but he came not nor did he hear from him. A day or two before his death he said he saw his mother and sisters, and appeared to be conversing with them, and said he wanted to be with them. He has left a widow and five children to do as best they may in this cold world. The writer of this was with him in his last moments and closed his eyes. May he rest in peace.
